### DATA CONTROLLER

*The data controller is the natural or legal person that decides how to use the personal data collected and for what purposes.*

### DATA PROTECTION OFFICER

*The DPO is the party, designated by the data controller, who supports the latter in monitoring compliance with the GDPR, in raising awareness and providing information, as well as in other activities required by law, and acts as a point of contact for data subjects and supervisory authorities.*

### HOW WE IMPLEMENT COOKIES

*Cookies are strings of text that websites place and store inside the devices that users access the Internet with (smartphones, tablets, PCs...), so as to allow for the collection of information regarding the user’s browsing activity on the website (browsing data).*

*Cookies may be stored on the user’s device, with a variable lifespan (so-called “persistent” cookies), or they may expire when the browser is closed or have a limited lifespan (so-called “session” cookies).*

*Cookies may be installed directly by the website you are visiting (so-called “first-party” cookies) or they may be installed by other websites (so-called “third-party” cookies).*

*The same purposes may also be pursued through the use of other types of tracking technologies: in this case, the provisions relating to the use of cookies are applicable.*

The following is a brief description of the cookies and other tracking technologies that are used on the [eglagroup.com](http://eglagroup.com) website (hereinafter referred to as the “Site”).

**Technical cookies:** cookies used for the sole purpose of carrying out the transmission of a communication over the electronic communication network, or strictly necessary to enable you to browse the Site.

The Site uses the following types of technical cookies:

- a. **session cookies:** the use of so-called session cookies (which are not permanently stored on your computer and disappear when the browser is closed) is strictly limited to the transmission of session identifiers necessary to enable the safe and efficient exploration of the Site. They do not require your consent.
- b. **persistent cookies:** persistent cookies remain on the device even after the user leaves the Site, until they are deleted, or they expire. The Site creates these cookies and stores them on your device so that it can read them when you visit the Site again. This allows, for example, for the preferences that you have set to be maintained on subsequent visits to the Site. They do not require your consent.

**Analytic cookies:** cookies installed for the purpose of collecting information, of a statistical and aggregate nature (length of stay on the Site, number of visitors – also possibly divided by geographic area – time slot of the connection and/or other characteristics), to analyse website visits and to improve the content offer. As long as such cookies are first-party and do not allow the data subject to be identified, they do not require consent. The Site uses first-party analytic cookies to analyse users’ browsing, to produce statistics on website visits or to improve the content offer.

**Profiling cookies:** cookies installed for the purpose of tracking the user’s browsing activity on the website and creating profiles of his/her tastes, habits, choices, etc. By using these cookies, advertising messages can be sent in accordance with the preferences that the single user has previously expressed when browsing online.

**The Site does not use profiling cookies.**

## PROVISION OF DATA

*For some processing purposes, it is necessary for you to provide your data – without which it would not be possible to pursue the purpose of the processing. For other purposes, provision of the Data may be optional.*

Browsing data are processed by the Controller, during the browsing, by installing technical cookies: such cookies are necessary to ensure the correct functioning of the Site, and their use does not require your prior consent.

According to the Italian Authority (Garante per la Protezione dei Dati Personali), tracking tools that are used on the Site, which are comparable to analytic cookies, are to be considered as equivalent to technical cookies. Such comparison is due to the fact that they are used for site optimisation purposes directly by the owner of the Site, who collects statistical information in aggregate form on the number of users and their interaction with the Site itself. Therefore, their use does not require your prior consent.



## DATA RECIPIENTS

*In order to pursue the purposes of processing outlined in this information notice, the Controller may transmit some of your data to external parties, who act as data controllers and/or processors.*

*A data processor is a natural or legal person that processes data on behalf of the controller: the purposes and means of processing are always determined by the data controller.*

The data may be communicated to external subjects acting as **data controllers**, including, by way of example, authorities as well as supervisory and control bodies and, in general, subjects, public or private, entitled to request the data.

The data may also be processed, on behalf of the Controller, by **subjects appointed as data processors**, who are given adequate operating instructions. These subjects may belong, by way of example, to the following categories: companies that perform the management and/or maintenance service of the Site and companies that provide services for the management of the information system and telecommunications networks.

## PERSONS AUTHORISED TO PROCESS

*Personal data protection legislation requires that the persons authorised to process personal data be identified and given specific instructions regarding the processing.*

The data may be processed by the employees of the company functions tasked with the pursuit of the aforementioned purposes, who have been expressly authorised to process the data and who have received adequate operating instructions pursuant to Article 29 of the GDPR and Article 2-quaterdecies of Italian Legislative Decree 196/2003, as amended and adapted by Italian Legislative Decree 101/2018.



## TRANSFER OF PERSONAL DATA to NON-EU COUNTRIES

*Personal data benefit from specific safeguards within the European Union. For this reason, the GDPR requires that data subjects be informed of any transfer of data outside the Union. Such transfers must be accompanied by additional safeguards.*

There are no transfers of data outside the European Union.



## RIGHTS OF THE DATA SUBJECT and COMPLAINT TO THE SUPERVISORY AUTHORITY

*The GDPR grants various rights to the data subject, which must be made known by the data controller through the information notice on the processing of personal data, in a concise, transparent, intelligible and easily accessible form.*

Data subjects may also object to the processing in cases of legitimate interest of the Data Controller pursuant to Article 21 GDPR.

Where processing is based on consent or on the performance of a contract and is carried out by automated means, data subjects have the right to receive the data in a structured, commonly used and machine-readable format and, if technically feasible, to transmit them to another data controller without hindrance.

Finally, data subjects have the right to lodge a complaint with the competent supervisory authority.
